How to Register Your Volunteer Organization

- Amherst orgs, head to <u>www.amherstrec.org</u>; Milford orgs, head to <u>www.milfordrec.com</u>
- One individual per organization registers.
- A race director will contact you via email with race day information and job assignments. Possible jobs include: water/aid stations, directing on routes, kids triathlon, and more!

Race-Day Restrictions:

- A maximum of 20 organizations will be needed. Registration is first come, first serve
- Individuals volunteering on race day need to be ages 10+. Volunteers under 18 also need to have an adult present.
- Organizations should provide a group of 5-8 people for race-day volunteering.
- Fun costumes, speakers, and noisemakers are all encouraged but must not interfere with the athletes or the volunteer's responsibilities.
- If volunteer hours need signing off, please bring the paper on race-day and find a race director.
